

**Pleasant View Fire Protection District**  
**Meeting Minutes**  
Sunday May 24, 2026

The meeting of the Pleasant View Fire Protection District Board of Directors was called to order by Jeremy Rosenbaugh at 7:00 p.m.

Board Members present were Jeremy Rosenbaugh, Dean Ives, Walt Henes and Jim Johnson. Additionally, Landan Wilson Administrative Assistant; Angela Rohwer, Fire Chief; John Riedel, and Tracy Montgomery were present.

**District Business**

**Minutes:** The minutes for the May 19<sup>th</sup> Board meeting were tabled till the regular June 16<sup>th</sup> Board Meeting.

**Old Business**

- **Water Tanks** – Angela provided a copy of the water tanks summary. She is asking for board approval to grant up to \$60,000 for water tanks. Walt suggested tabling it for another meeting until more information is gathered. Jim asked if it would lower ISO insurance for water tanks. Dean stated that ISO rating would be for water trucks not underground water tanks. The more water on standby the better. Walt made motion to table, dean seconded. Motion passed.
- **Open District Position Job Description and Pay Rate** – The board compiled a list of responsibilities for the new district position in preparation to have the listing posted on Wednesday May 27<sup>th</sup>. Angela had invited Tracey Montgomery to the meeting to give the board an idea of tasks that she performs as secretary for the Dolores Fire Protection District. Tracey agreed that a lot of what she does fits with the job description the board put together. Tracey figured she puts in 15-20 hours a month. Jeremy asked if she would be willing to help or consult with the district when the new position is filled. Tracey said she would be willing to help out. The board discussed pay rate, Tracey mentioned a couple years ago Dolores was paying \$500/ Month but has since increased to \$1,000/month. Walt made a motion to approve the job description and pay \$1,000/month for the new district position. Jimmy seconded. Motion carried.

**New Business**

- **District Board Member Vacancy Appointment** – Dean introduced John Riedel as being a potential candidate to fill the open board position. John mentioned he doesn't know a lot about the district and how it functions but is willing to serve the community. John stated that he is a licensed attorney and currently works for a local bank. Jimmy made a motion to appoint John Riedel as interim board member until the next election cycle. Dean seconded the motion. Motion Carried. Jeremy will contact the attorney to get John sworn in.

**Public Comment**




**Executive Session**
